



Jr. High Suggested Supply List

1. Five (5) – loose-leaf binders (preferably 2” - this size works the best in different colours!)
-Math -Language Arts -Social St. -Science -PLS/Options/PE
*Having all subjects in one extra large binder just does not work!
2. Paper: a) loose-leaf, b) unlined paper, c) graph paper
3. Blue / black pens
4. Pencils (HB)
5. White-out / liquid Paper / correction tape
6. Erasers – preferably white
7. Glue / Glue stick
8. 30 cm ruler
9. Highlighter pens
10. Geometry set
11. Pencil crayons / fine tipped felts
12. Six Duo-tangs
13. ROUND NOSE scissors (pointed tip violates the Weapons Policy)
14. Calculator – a calculator in the \$15 - \$20 range that will handle the basic arithmetic functions, plus sin, cos, and tan will probably be sufficient. It should have a **fraction button** if it is to be used to the end of Grade 9. Recommended models include: TI 30x IIB, Sharp EL 531V or 531W, or Casio fx 99IMS. It is **not recommended** for students to purchase the much more expensive TI-83 series until they require its capabilities at the high school level. Far too many calculators are lost and this is an unnecessary expense at the Jr. High level.
15. Pencil box or case to carry it all around in.
16. Dictionary – French/English or Spanish/English if taking those complementary courses.
17. Gym clothing: clean non-marking running shoes, T-shirt, sweats / shorts (IHS clothing is available for those who choose to purchase clothing with school logos).

IMPORTANT: This is a suggested list of BASIC supplies used in Jr. High. Individual teachers may have special material needs for specific classes. ie. Coil notebook for notes in some classes
