Alberta Education and Chinook's Edge School Division have partnered in a new data gathering activity, designed to help us get quality information from students about what needs to be changed to improve our schools. The "Tell Them From Me" survey (TTFM), will be administered to all students in grades 9, 11, and 12 before November 24th. The anonymous survey data will be collected and combined, so that all results will be shown as a group. In this way, individual responses will be protected. We will be using the data to determine trends, and areas of concern so that we can make informed decisions about what issues need to be addressed.

If you have concerns about your child's participation in this survey, please let us know as soon as possible, so that we can make sure they do not participate in this survey.

Students in grades 8, 10, and 12 will participate in the annual Alberta Education Accountability Pillar survey and Schollie survey in the spring. As well, parent input will be encouraged in both of these surveys, to help us target key initiatives for improvement. We would like honest communication of both our strengths and weaknesses so that we can fix the problems and build on the solid areas.
