- Minimum 16 years of age
- Successfully completed TEC 1000 and/or WLD 1167 at Olds College
- On track for high school graduation and are recommended by their school for their strong efforts in current high school courses
- Have completed at a minimum English 20-2, Math 20-3 and Science 10
- Students must have completed HCS 3000, HCS 3010 and Construction Safety Training Systems [CSTS] (available through your high school offcampus coordinator)
- Mature, punctual and reliable with a strong work ethic and willingness to learn
- Able to commit to the duration of the program and attend training Monday to Thursday from 1:30 to 4:30 for 16 weeks.
- Transportation to the training site in Innisfail
- CSA approved steel-toed boots all other PPE supplied
