Technician Basics (TEC 1000)

In this introductory course, the student will gain an understanding of apprenticeship safety, shop procedures and practices. Students will learn the use and care of selected measuring, hand and power tools, workplace safety and common industry practices. These modules are found in all trades training. Get a sneak peek and grow your skill!

** Tuition fees are covered by the Chinook's Edge School Division. Only a \$100 materials fee is charged by Olds College to the student. PPE is required and the responsibility of the student. **

Introductory Welding (WLD 1167)

Students will gain an understanding of the safety, theory and techniques of oxy-Acetylene welding and cutting, shielded metal arc welding, and gas metal arc welding. They will study electrode selection, welding metallurgy, repair and fabrication procedures and metal joint preparation. Excellent course to begin to build apprentice ship welding skill.
