## **AgSmart 2023**

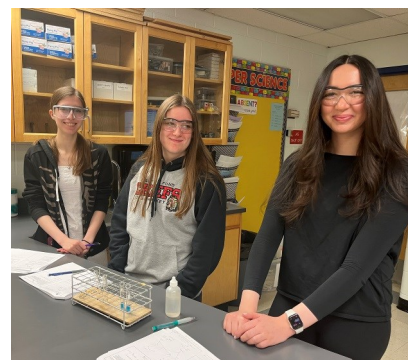
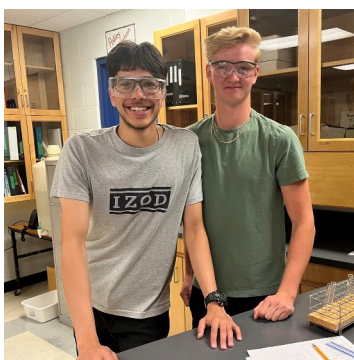
