IHS Dress Code

Student clothing should contribute to a positive school atmosphere and be appropriate for an educational/professional setting. If clothing isn't appropriate to wear at a typical workplace, it is likely not acceptable at school. Students wearing clothing that is deemed by staff as not school appropriate will be asked to change, cover the offending garment, or return home to change. Students must not wear the article of clothing in the future. It is at the discretion of school administration and school staff to determine the appropriateness of dress. Repeated offenses and/or failure to comply may result in further disciplinary action. If students or parents require clarification, please contact the administration.

1) Students must wear at all times:

- An opaque shirt (with straps/sleeves and fabric in the front, back, and on the sides under the arms, and that covers the midriff to the belly button, covering the ribs), AND
- Pants or the equivalent (for example, a skirt, sweatpants, leggings, a dress or shorts) that fully cover the buttocks and underwear, AND
- Shoes (or sandals)
- 2) Students cannot wear any clothing (including hats and headwear) that has:
 - Violent language or images
 - Images or language depicting drugs, alcohol, or any illegal item or activity (eg. beer logos, marijuana leaves)
 - Hate speech, profanity, or pornography (eg. the Playboy logo)
 - Images or language that creates a hostile or intimidating environment based on any protected class or consistently marginalized groups
 - Any clothing that reveals visible undergarments (visible waistbands and visible bra straps are permitted)
 - Accessories that are within the above image list, or those that could be considered dangerous or could be used as a weapon.
